On March 26th 1569 the Council issued a directive to the counties to hold a general muster of all men over 16, appointing commissioners in each county. Certificates of the muster, with the names of the men and their equipment, were to be returned by July 1st though this was later extended to August 12th. This CD contains a searchable transcript for Devon of this Muster.

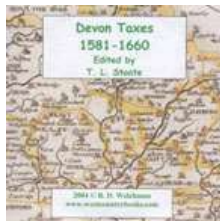

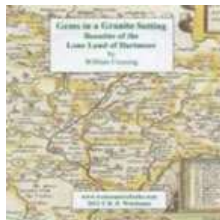

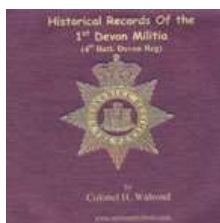


Gems in a Granite Setting (William Crossing)
