

Cemeteries' Records – Cemetery Factsheet

Cullompton Cemetery



Cullompton Town Cemetery was established in 1856, and is owned, managed and maintained by Cullompton Town Council on behalf of the parish community. Some of the burials from 1856 onwards which were recorded in the Cullompton parish burial register, held in the Devon Heritage Centre, actually took place in this cemetery rather than in the churchyard. The heritage centre holds some Cullompton Burial Board records (see below), however, the cemetery burial registers are still held by Cullompton Town Council.
